

## Principal Policing Practitioner

At the December 2018 meeting the PRSB appointed Peter Bull (Deputy President, Registration) to formally undertake functions as Principal Policing Practitioner. In this capacity he will support staff and members across all PRSB functions.

Peter is a former Superintendent of Victoria Police who served for 39 years and worked in corporate, operational, service and training roles in metropolitan and rural areas. He performed Government liaison and industrial relations duties, managed corporate projects, a large station and several operational divisions. He is a graduate of the Australian Institute of Police Management, a Williamson Fellow (Leadership Victoria) and was awarded the Australian Police Medal. First appointed to the Board in 2014 and re-appointed in 2016, Peter served on the Review and Professional Standards Divisions. He was appointed Acting Deputy President (Registration) in December 2016 and on an ongoing basis in June 2017.

PRSB staff and members regularly draw on Peter's knowledge. PRSB has formalised this arrangement so that Peter's role will now include supporting our Review and Professional Standards functions by:

- Providing an internal source of contemporary expertise and policing knowledge;
- Identifying developments and trends in policing methods and knowledge; and
- Advising PRSB Members and staff about contemporary policing practice to assist in the performance of their functions.
